

Dear Key Appointment Holders and EA Personnel,

1. On 22 Apr 2022, the Government announced [the removal of pre-departure test requirements for fully vaccinated air/sea travellers](#).

#### **Removal of Pre-Departure Test Requirements from 26 Apr 2022, 0001 hours**

2. From 26 Apr 2022, 0001 hours, all fully vaccinated travellers, including migrant domestic workers (MDWs) and confinement nannies (CNs) **arriving via air or sea checkpoints from countries/regions in the General Travel category** can enter Singapore without the need to undergo pre-departure tests.

3. With this move, all fully vaccinated travellers, including migrant domestic workers (MDWs) and confinement nannies (CNs) **arriving via land, air, or sea checkpoints from countries/regions in the General Travel category** will not require any tests to enter Singapore.

4. All work pass holders entering Singapore must be fully vaccinated before arrival. Please refer to the [checklist](#) for fully vaccinated travellers. Unvaccinated and non-fully vaccinated MDWs/CNs will not be permitted to enter. Travellers who are medically exempted from receiving the COVID-19 vaccination will be required to fulfil the following additional requirements:

- a. A pre-departure test within 2 days before arrival in Singapore;
- b. Undergo a 7-day SHN; and
- c. Take a PCR test at the end of the SHN period.

#### **Resumption of Cross-Border Bus Services and Taxis with Malaysia from 1 May 2022**

5. From 1 May 2022, the Land Transport Authority (LTA), together with the public transport operators, will resume the operation of cross-border bus services. Cross-border taxi operations will also resume from 1 May 2022. Fully vaccinated MDWs/CNs from the General Travel category can use the cross-border bus and taxi services to enter Singapore.
